Reeve Bill Dowbyhuz called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Dave Shwaluk advised the group that the Manitoba Water Services Board's prime objective is to help municipalities and legal water co-ops with water and water infrastructure. They have been contacted about extending water from the Rural Municipality of Whitemouth to the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet and the Local Government District of Pinawa. There is a 1/3 grant that they can pay towards these initiatives maybe in 2017 but not 2016. It is not possible to determine what the costs will be until a budget is done for the project. The water treatment plant in the Rural Municipality of Whitemouth is fairly new, and has the capacity to accommodate the water requests. Every connection paid just over \$3,000.00 capital cost, and everyone who hooks into the water system has to pay that cost as well.

Mr. Shwaluk then answered ratepayer inquiries.
