a) Siting of buildings and manure storage facilities;	-
b) Provincial approval of a permit for the manure storage facility, a Water Rights Licence being	
obtained if exceeding 5,500 lmp. gal./day, and a registration of a manure management plan;	
c) Financial contributions to infrastructure improvements;	
d) Odour control measures;	
e) Confirmation of long term contracts for leased spread fields
