BY-LAW NO. 575/11

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHITEMOUTH TO CLOSE A MUNICIPAL ROAD

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides in part as follows:


- 290(1) Subject to subsection (2), a municipality may close a municipal road by
- (a) passing a by-law closing the road;
 - (b) obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
 - (c) registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office.


AND WHEREAS the following described municipal road is no longer required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be closed:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth enacts as follows:

1. THAT all that portion of Parcel A, Part of Plan 3427; (Deposit 757/2011) in the northwest quarter of Section 28-13-11 EPM shall be closed.
2. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the road closing.

DONE AND PASSED as a by-law of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth in the Province of Manitoba this 26 day of October, 2011.
