Burning Permits are required from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup>, available at Conservation offices.

Contact the Whitemouth Fire Department Fire Chief Ron Toews at 348-2133 when you are going to burn, this eliminates the fire department from going to non emergency calls.

## **BUILDING/DEMOLITION PERMITS**

Are you planning on building, renovating or demolishing? A permit issued by the Building Inspector/Development Officer is required prior to commencing any project. Contact the office or email [bldg@rmwhitemouth.com](mailto:bldg@rmwhitemouth.com) Preparation is the key to having your project take shape as smoothly as possible. Check the website for a check list of the process and required documents, which may be a necessity.

**CONTRACTORS** - ensure all permits are in place before any work begins!
