Spring is coming! Please be careful when burning grass and brush.

Burning Permits are required from April 1st to November 15th, available at Conservation offices.

Contact Fire Chief Ron Toews at 348-2133 when you are going to burn, this eliminates the fire department from going to nonemergency calls.

The winter season is almost behind us and hasn't offered very much moisture this year. Environment Canada has predicted low precipitation over April & May, therefore beware of the possibility of a dry Spring. Always be aware of wildfires when the weather is warm, dry and windy. Wildfire season typically begins in April and runs throughout the summer months. Human caused wildfires are most common during the Spring before green up when vegetation has very little moisture. Avoid outdoor burning in warm windy conditions. The ground may have some moisture but the vegetation doesn't.
