Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit

Province of Manitoba will increase the Homeowners Tax Credit to a maximum of \$1,600.00 for the 2026 year.

It will be applied directly on the municipal property tax statement, to those that are residential properties and are designated a principal residence.

Eligible homeowners who do not receive the credit on their tax statement can claim the credit on their 2026 income tax returns.

Burning Permits are required from April 1st to November 15th, available at Conservation offices.
